

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ii. Research

1. It was proposed that in the University the mandate of University Grants Commission (UGC) Ph.D. regulation must be adhered to. After discussion amongst the members of the Academic Council it was suggested that a committee of 3 members shall be constituted to give specific recommendations within two months on how and with what variations to adopt the UGC guidelines. The Vice-Chancellor was authorized to take decision on these recommendations which would then be laid before the Academic Council for information in its next meeting.
 - a. Regarding approving of '**Association of Indian University (AIU) recognized Post graduate programmes as equivalent to Post graduate degree for the purpose of admissions in Ph.D. programme**' the Academic Council suggested to form an Equivalence Committee which can decide the matter on case to case basis.
 - b. It was suggested by the Council that signing of MoU with INFLIBNET (UGC data base) shall be done after the adoption of UGC guidelines by the University.
 - c. The members approved the Thesis Format Guidelines with the observation that if suggestions for their improvement are submitted by the members within a month, the same would be considered and disposed of by the Vice-Chancellor.
 - d. Members of the Council suggested that the formats related to Research programme (Forms R1- R7) shall be circulated to all the Deans of all the Schools of the University. The modifications suggested shall be suitably incorporated and presented for approval in the next Academic Council meeting.
 - e. The honorarium to be paid for evaluation of Ph.D. thesis and conducting of Viva-Voce was approved by the Council as follows:

 - f. The Council suggested that a detailed proposal should be worked out and presented in next Academic Council meeting regarding status change of Ph.D. candidate from 'working professional' to 'full-time scholar' and vice-versa.
 - g. The Council discussed whether to follow the UGC mandate in order to proceed in awarding Ph.D. to Mr. Ashok Suhag (RA/FA, School of Engineering) without the completion of 8 credits course work.




Mr. Ashok Suhag joined the University on 03rd May 2010 as Research/Faculty Associate, School of Engineering and his date of Registration was 23rd Dec., 2010, as per the then GBU Ordinance it was not mandatory to complete 8 credits course work. Mr. Ashok Suhag has submitted his Ph.D. Thesis, therefore taking his in-person request of conducting the Viva-Voce without pursuing his course work, was taken into consideration by the Council.

After deliberation on the issue and taking into consideration Mr. Suhag's unwillingness to do course work before viva-voce the Council decided that his viva-voce shall be conducted without further insisting on pre Ph.D. course work.

- h. It was recommended by the Council that in case of all already registered Ph.D. students the conditions as applicable on the date of their registration shall only be enforced and if they do not require pre-Ph.D. course work, such course work may be left to the choice of the concerned Ph.D. scholar.

11.09 To discuss and approve that the General Proficiency (GP) credit course may be removed from the course curriculum of the students from the Academic Batch 2014-15.

The Academic Council recommended that a detailed proposal shall be worked out in this regard and shall be presented in the next Academic Council meeting.

11.10 To discuss the rules for change of branch and transfer of the student from one School to another School of the University.

The Academic Council recommended forming a committee which would go deep into this matter and make specific recommendations for consideration by the Vice-Chancellor.

11.11 To discuss and approve the modified rules of Professional Development Allowance (PDA).

The Council approved the modifications as proposed hereunder:

In addition to oral presentation, poster presentation in standard conferences/symposia may also be considered for grant of PDA. b. Grant of PDA may also be given for attending National and International workshop.

11.12 To discuss the readmission of Mr. Himanshu Sharma, student of School of Information & Communication Technology, who was expelled from the University on the basis of misconduct.

The Council strongly disapproved of the behavior of Mr. Himanshu Sharma (student of School of Information & Communication Technology) and it was decided unanimously that the student shall not be readmitted in the University.



The existing Admission Committee (as in Annexure I & II) was accorded post-facto approval by the Council.


11.14 Any other matter with the permission of Chairman.
